During this very trying time – while emotionally coping with the death of his father – Michael had the added task of managing a corporation, of which he had little reality. He invested a lot of time and effort to studying corporate structure and law in order to do the best job possible. (Not to mention the actual physical energy needed in moving and consolidating the offices themselves.) Michael was faced with making some very difficult decisions, and in hindsight, perhaps it was due to his detached viewpoint, he ultimately was able to fulfill his purpose for, and with, Three In One Concepts.

With the help of the Executive Committee, he accomplished far more than “keeping the corporation afloat.” Amongst their specific accomplishments, they fine-tuned the current Agreements, originally initiated by Gillian, Gordon and Daniel. They also furnished the “Criteria for Consideration to Become a Specialized Trainer, Intermediate Faculty & Faculty.” Michael also continued to research and obtain intellectual legal rights for Three In One Concepts, specifically in Germany with help from Dorothea Schultz and a German

attorney. (This work is being vigorously continued through our current attorney.)

For one-and-a-half years, Michael put his life on hold. We are grateful to him for creating the opportunity for the Corporation to continue functioning. Through necessary cost cutting and re-organization, he gave the Corporation clear fiscal insight.

Members of the Executive Committee, who actively pursued a role in assisting Michael define and fulfill his purpose with, and for, Three In One Concepts also put their lives on hold. It was upon their insistence that the Burbank headquarters remained open when Michael took charge.

We wish Michael all the best as he continues to fulfill his life.

The Future of Three In One Concepts

This means reaching the public by creating a new, separate “path” for those who want the personal benefits of Three In One’s Concepts. We are calling this The Life Enhancement Path (LEP).

Who can attend this series? Anyone who completes *Tools of The Trade* through *Advanced One Brain* will have the opportunity to continue on the Life Enhancement Path, beginning with *Relationships In Jeopardy* through *The Child As The Parent*. This is not to be

confused with the same programs on the Certification Training Path (CTP).

People on the Life Enhancement Path, at any time, can transfer to Certification Training. They are then responsible for taking all required programs on the Certification Training Path.



Note: Faculty is not automatically authorized to present the LEP series. Authorization to present the LEP series will be by OUR INVITATION ONLY. After Gala 2009, we will invite to instruct the Life Enhancement Path model ONLY those who

- 1. Have proven themselves to fully grasp the Hologram concept, both in general presentations and individual consultations;*
- 2. Have demonstrated its positive use in their own personal and professional lives;*
- 3. Have had good, clear communication with Burbank.*

Text Revision & Program Re-structuring

As stated at Gala 2008, we are undertaking the much needed text revision and program restructuring.

This will include all revised text information previously published in *Catching-UPs* and the program pages presented at Gala 2004 and 2005. Also, we will eliminate or modify any sections of texts, which might be legally questionable by the psychological and/or medical establishments.

The re-structuring of program contents will also incorporate the Hologram Concept, represented by *The 6th Element*, *Numbers* and material from *Master Class in S/F*.

Our goal is to consolidate all the information, so that they are where they need to be - in the manuals themselves.

In addition, *Under The Code* and *Louder Than Words* will be getting new photographs and various programs will be getting defusion processes changed and/or deleted.

Obviously, this involves major changes, additions, and re-structuring of the Certification Programs, as well as major text revisions. (We will outline all this at Gala 2009 in Kyoto.)

Note: Anastazy and I began these revisions in Japan in April 2008, thanks to Emiko and Toshō’s insistence, and I continue this review of text and program contents on a daily basis.

Very Important

This restructuring is why the Agreements you sign require your taking these Re-Certification Programs, which replace part(s) of the Update Requirements through Pre-Gala 2012. These Re-Certification Programs are full of new focused information. They are based on how to incorporate the principles of *The 6th Element* and *The Hologram of Three In One Concepts* into each Training Program. This changes how to instruct each program and gives insight into how to most effectively facilitate sessions.

These Re-Certification/Updates are all about the essence of the Work – making it easier, clearer and more productive.

As you are aware, the program manuals have gone through numerous revisions, some more than others. Our publishers over the years have been most gracious and understanding throughout our history.

If you choose to continue as a Three In One Concepts authorized representative and want to be listed on our website as a Consultant and/or an Instructor who can purchase text materials and certificates, you must send us your signed Agreement(s) and attend the new Re-Certification Update Programs.

Clarification:

Why are we requesting for your Record of Training? Because truth-to-tell, between a minimum of two database crashes and data-input delinquency/oversight, Three In One Concepts' database has never been complete.

We now have a new database physically located in Burbank and data being manually inputted diligently and completely. This is our commitment to ourselves and to those who represent and support the Work.

Why are the current Agreements for Consultant Facilitators, Adv. Consultant Facilitators, Instructors and Adv. Instructors for only one year? Because we are in the business of finalizing these Agreements, together with all other written materials.

The Agreements have been a work-in-progress since their inception, and we believe it is time for Burbank to make some clear Choices and commitments. The Agreements are reminders to us – in Burbank – of *our* commitment, (*our* responsibility,) and *our* relationship to the Work, as well as to those who choose to represent the Work of Three In One Concepts to the public.

Essentially, the next Agreements will be an extension through Pre-Gala 2012 of the current Agreements with only minor changes.

The bottom line is: We are “MIND-ing Our Business.” We are focused and committed to re-claiming who we truly are and to creating the reality we choose to have by aligning our personal and professional lives into Oneness.

Review

Why the LEP Program?

Up to now, we followed Gordon's assumption that everyone who began the Training Path would become a Consultant and Instructor. However, experience makes it clear that most people do not want to learn how to do this Work, but they do want its personal benefits.

This is a significant shift in our emphasis from “professional modality” to Life Enhancement. This new Path opens to the public, the personal benefits of the Work.

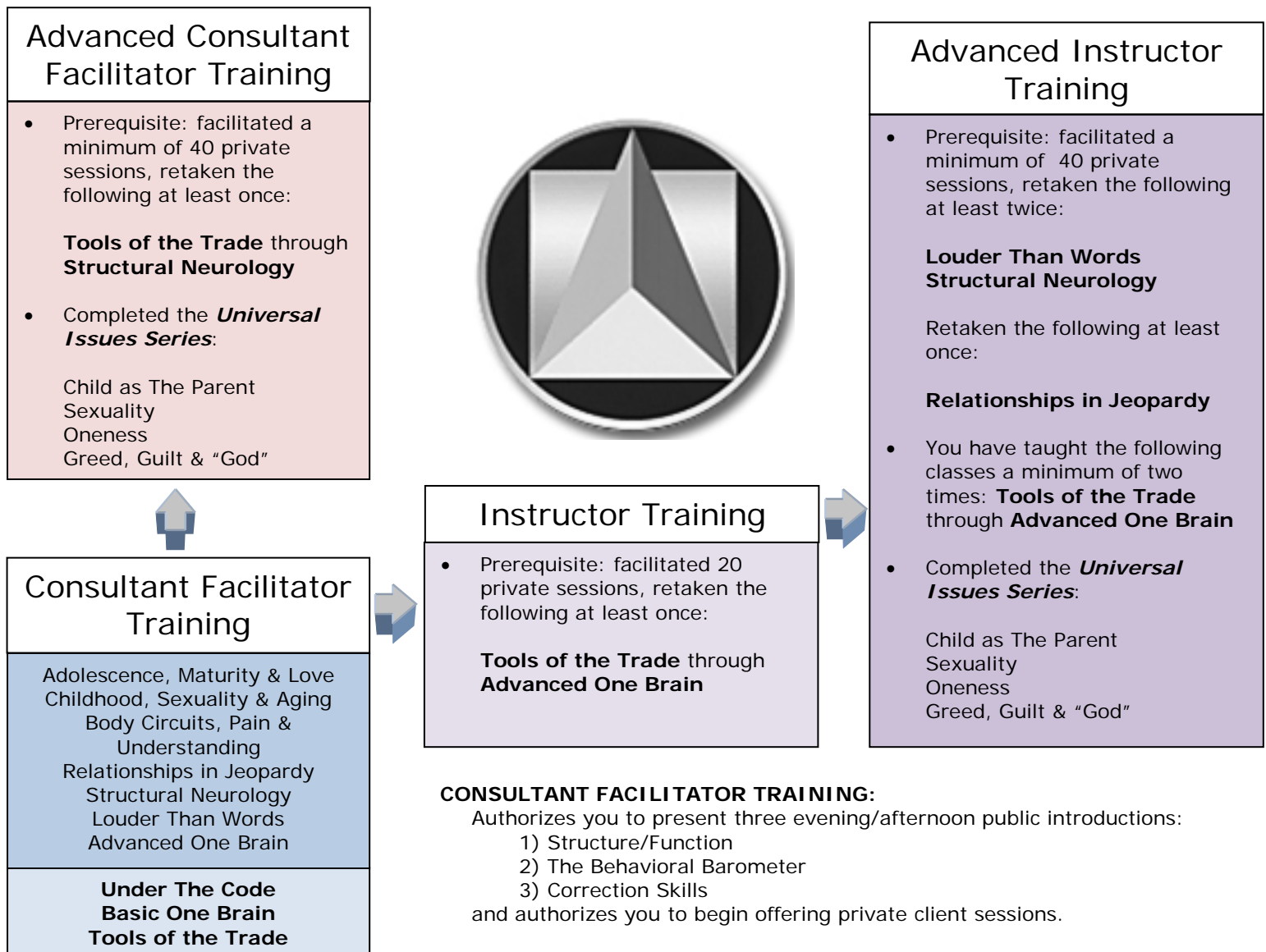

2009 – 2012 Re-Certification/Update

At Gala 2009, we will present the Revised Certification Training Path. By Gala 2010 we will finalize the English language text revisions and the re-structuring of *Tools of the Trade* through *Relationships In Jeopardy*.

Please keep in CONSIDERATION this REALITY, as you read the remainder of this section:

For years, Three In One Concepts has asked that you fulfill your Update Requirements every two years – the Update (14 hours) plus an additional 21 hours by repeating or taking training on the Training Path. During a four-year period, that amounts to a minimum of 70 hours total.

We are now asking you to fulfill the following requirements by Pre-Gala 2012. These “Update Requirements” are based on different criteria – the anticipated final text/program revisions, the Revised Certification Training Path, and Life-Enhancement Path. They can be looked upon as Re-Certification/Updates.

Consultant Facilitator:

Gala 2008 through Pre-Gala 2010: The current 2008-2010 Update (14 hours), plus a minimum of 21 additional hours. (1-days do not count as Update hours.)

Gala 2010 through Pre-Gala 2012: To Be Announced.

Advanced Consultant Facilitator:

Gala 2008 through Pre-Gala 2012: The current 2008-2010 Update (14 hours); the 3-day Advanced Consultant Facilitator Re-Certification Update (available after Gala 2009); plus a minimum of 21 additional hours of training on the Certification Training Paths 2008 – 2012. You would then be an authorized 2009 – 2012 *Advanced Consultant Facilitator*.

Instructor, who is a Consultant Facilitator:

Gala 2008 through Pre-Gala 2012: Instructor Re-Certification Update when it becomes available in 2010; plus a minimum of 21 additional hours of training on the Certification Training Paths 2008 – 2012.

You would then be an authorized 2009 – 2012 *Consultant Facilitator/Instructor*.

Instructor, who is a Consultant Facilitator and has completed ALL of the 4 Universal Issues Programs:

Gala 2008 through Pre-Gala 2012: The 3-day Advanced Consultant Facilitator Re-Certification Update (available after Gala 2009), and Instructor Re-Certification Update when it becomes available in 2010.

You will then be an authorized 2009 – 2012 *Instructor/Advanced Consultant Facilitator*.

Advanced Instructor, whether they are a Consultant Facilitator or an Advanced Consultant Facilitator:

Gala 2008 through Pre-Gala 2012: The 3-day Advanced Consultant Facilitator Re-certification Update (available after Gala 2009), the 3-day Instructor and the 3-day Advanced Instructor Re-certification Updates when they become available in 2010.

You would then be an authorized 2009 – 2012 *Advanced Instructor/Advanced Consultant Facilitator*.

The total number of hours required for re-certification, even for Advanced Instructors, who have the most number of hours to fulfill, (after Faculty, Intermediate Faculty and Specialized Trainers), still amounts to less than 70 hours total.

Additional Faculty, Intermediate Faculty and Specialized Trainer Update information will follow when it is available.

These hours will fulfill all “update requirements” through Pre-Gala 2012 .

Grand-Parenting Back In

We are choosing to offer one final opportunity for those wanting to grand-parent back in.

If you did not take the 2006 – 2008 Update, and/or did not fulfill the required Update Hours, you have the opportunity to grand-parent in by taking the 2008 – 2010 Update, plus fulfilling an additional 35 hours of training on the Current Certification Training Path. When we receive and review your Agreement(s) and your Record of Training, showing completion of grand-parenting in requirements, you can be listed on our website.

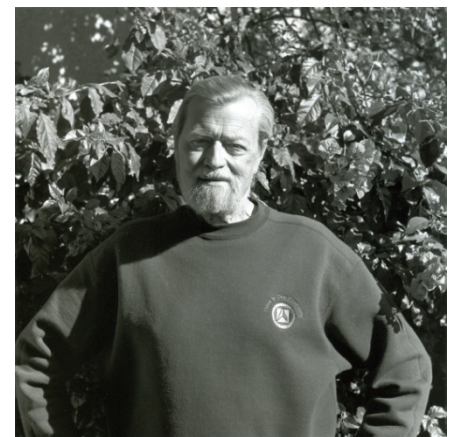
Daniel Is Back And He's "Got Your Number"

Summary of 2008 Pre-Gala Meetings in Budapest

During the meeting the new President, Anastazyia Wada, shared her perspective of the principles of the future of Three In One Concepts:

Having purchased Michael Stokes' shares, Anastazyia is now the majority shareholder. Daniel and Gillian hold their shares unchanged. (This autumn, Daniel bought Gillian's 2 percent shares.)

Whilst giving credit to the accomplishments achieved by Michael Stokes in his capacity as President, especially in cost reduction, Anastazyia showed a clear view of the changes to be achieved with a new beginning. It is the job/responsibility of the Burbank, home-office, to be/model aware, direct, honest, responsible communication within itself first.

The "Work" is based on Choice and Acceptance and is really about the individual human being. Relationships are the heart of the "Work," starting with the relationship with Self inside, from where all other relationships are born and nurtured.

The year 2008 (as a number) represents a new beginning and the focus on oneself, leaving behind/completing/ending the "survival mode," which tends to put the focus outside instead of the Self and inside.

Burbank will reopen as a centre and schedule classes. Instructors will teach training Path programs, while Daniel will be offering his new creations.

Catching-UP will be reactivated, preferably in electronic form, and translations prepared before sending it out. It will be the primary source of information. The next edition shall cover clearly questions raised during the Pre-Gala meetings.

The royalty system stays as is.
Publisher's contracts stay.

From the work of the Executive Committee the following will be implemented:

Application criteria for Faculty, Int. Faculty and Specialized Trainers – therefore all applications, new or pending will be handled according to this procedure in Burbank;

Agreements generally as written with modifications, the status will be changed to "contract" in the future;

"Sponsorship" remains terminated - sponsoring is between Sponsor and Trainer - but Three in One Concepts, Inc. reserves the right to encourage and/or organize sponsored classes anywhere at any time.

Sponsoring classes with Daniel is only arranged through "Stokes/Whiteside" in a separate agreement. Daniel is fully booked through the year 2009.

Many of the items to be decided upon will be handled in Burbank by the new President together with Daniel, again taking up actively the role as Vice-President.

Specific needs of individual countries or areas will be dealt with in Burbank.

This refers also to the Training Path and the controversial expectations towards it.

Several projects will be defined and Work Groups established, as needed, with people able and ready to involve themselves in different tasks. (An example is the desired Instructor Outline for every class (teaching manual), which may be given to a task group as a project.)

This replaces the structure of the Executive Committee.

Anastazyia emphasized the importance of the work done by the Committee and its contribution to the continuation of Three In One Concepts.

The next year will be used for a major cleanup.

Straight and clear perspectives shall be central in the undertakings of the future.
Clear and uncontroversial communication shall come from Burbank.

Items to be addressed are the following:

Establish the Burbank website and database, and resolve associated problems;

Revisit the finalization of the Training Path;

Final revision of manuals and update of defusion sheets (over a two-year period);

“Grand-parenting in” one more time those who have decided to stay aside until now – the current Update 2008-2010 plus the relevant hours/classes will enable everybody to come on board without further requirements);

“Unauthorized training” - It is the goal for the next year to attract as many Instructors as possible to join the Three In One Concepts’ community (again) and encourage them to re-define their relationship with Burbank. In the future the Burbank website will name only authorized Instructors for reference, and publishers shall sell manuals solely to authorized Instructors;

Burbank will work on a system to be the only source for certificates in the future. The question, if numbering the certificates in order to keep track is a usable method, will be evaluated.

The amount of royalties was discussed as some Instructors claim problems with the payment. As this part of the tuition fee is not an income for the Instructor, it should be looked upon as payable to Three In One Concepts from the moment of collecting it. It was made clear that after the deduction of VAT from the money received for a class, the percentage of royalties has to be calculated.

The class, Without Stress Learning Can Be Easy, is an item to be evaluated. “Tactics” owns the book and Michael Stokes still owns “Tactics”. The book is still being published and publication royalties go to Michael Stokes. (Michael has offered to sell Tactics to Anastazyia.)

Daniel has not stopped being creative in the recent past. The new, projected structure of the expanded Training Program shall support his focus on creating a number of classes intended to gain the interest of the public and of clients for the Training Path. This means attracting people – Consultant Facilitators, as well as the public – to Three In One Concepts, with a focus on S/F + Barometer, S/F Master classes, short programs, etc. A start was given to this during his time spent in Europe in the fall of 2007.

The date for Gala 2009 is April 29 – May 2 and the location is Kyoto, Japan.

Anastazyia thanked everybody, present or absent, for all the work and commitment, as Three In One Concepts would not be where it is without all this dedication – “ALIVE”.

The criteria for our final decisions will be based on the criteria sheet put together by the Executive Committee and Michael Stokes. Please review this information before sending in your formal application:

Criteria For Consideration to Become Specialized Trainer, Intermediate Faculty or Faculty

Applicant shall have:

1. Completed ALL of the required programs on the Training Path up through Short Programs II and Advanced Consultant Facilitator. (Though not required, we encourage you to take all the programs on the Training Path Chart several times.)
2. Completed at least once ALL the REVISED Certification Programs: Consultant Facilitator, Instructor, Advanced Instructor, Advanced Consultant Facilitator (revisions in 2002 and 2003), Short Program Instructor I and Short Program Instructor II.
3. Signed and honored all the required agreements with Three In One Concepts. Applicant shall be current on royalties to Three In One Concepts, and shall have maintained good communication with Three In One Concepts and Faculty members.
4. Completed ALL Facilitator Updates at least once since 2006-2010.
5. Completed at **least twice**, the program they are requesting authorization to teach.
6. Been a very cooperative and communicative person, especially with colleagues, and defused their own issues as need be.
7. A proven record of running a well-operated, client-based Center where Three In One Concepts' programs are priority, and are offered more than any other modality. Applicants shall have offered all Training Path programs they are authorized to teach at least once per year and have provided an annual schedule to the Home Office.
8. Proven to be an excellent trainer. (i.e. We have received good feedback from their students).
9. Attended the Gala at least every two years, since 2006.
10. Given talks and one-day programs to the public.
11. Advertised in their own program schedules, for the past year or longer, the contact information for ALL Specialized Trainers and Intermediate Faculty in their area or country, as well as the titles and dates for ALL Faculty programs in their area or country.

And finally...

Applicants should be in an area, city or country that has a **NEED** for a Specialized Trainer or Faculty. This need is based on: Applicant's communication and co-operation with Intermediate Faculty/Faculty in their country or area. Applicant has taught all programs at least once a year and has taught classes up to, and including Relationships, at least five times with a minimum of four students in each class.
